

Game Play Sheet

1. Place conversation cards, upside down, on the game board, in the “open” mouth.
2. Take turns drawing a card and announcing the category identified.
3. Someone shouts, “Snapshot!” to indicate they have a thought or story to share. They proceed to name a family they have known or observed who represents one of the many ways this category is characterized by families. For instance, someone draws a card identifying “transportation” as the topic of conversation. Someone shouts, “Snapshot!” and declares that the Olson’s live in the city, so they don’t have to have a car because they always use the subway. Other snapshots may be shared.
4. Continue playing until everyone has had an opportunity to draw one or more conversation cards.
