The next meeting of the General Assembly of the National Council of the Churches of Christ in the USA (**NCC**) and Church World Service (**CWS**) will be held Tuesday, November 9, through Thursday, November 11, 2010, at the New Orleans Marriott at the Convention Center in New Orleans, LA.

The NCC and CWS – a community through which churches make visible their unity given in Christ and live responsibly in witness and service

The General Assembly is the biennial gathering of more than 250 delegates from the thirty-six member communions for legislation, worship, fellowship, and ecumenical sharing. This year there will be a special Centennial Gathering.

The Stewards Program offers a unique opportunity for young adults, ages 18-30, to encounter one aspect of the ecumenical movement from the inside. Ecumenical formation involves learning ecumenical theology and sharing the excitement and joy of worship and fellowship with others in the ecumenical movement. NCC/CWS invites stewards to the General Assembly to serve in the background and to observe up close the deliberative work of ecumenism.

Jesus prayed: “The glory that you have given me I have given them, **so that they may be one**, as we are one” (John 17:22 NRSV).

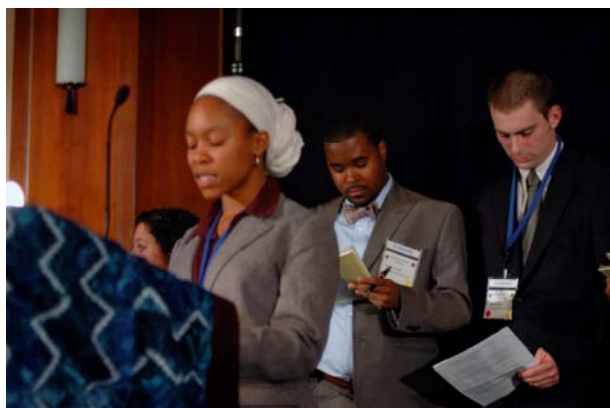
